Reminders



All mailed payments should go to Luminest 82 W. Queen St. Chambersburg, PA 17201. You may drop off payments in an envelope with your name and address placed in the locked box in front of the office. <u>Make checks out to Sunset</u>—NOT Luminest.

All of Luminest properties are smoke free. You may smoke outside—25 ft. from buildings— but please clean up you butts. Do not leave butts in flower pots, etc.

Reminder—Please clean up after your pet. This is in your Lease and in your Handbook.
All pets should be registered with the office. Your pet should be on a leash & under your control when outside. Please make certain that your child can handle walking and cleaning up after their pets as well. Thank you.

Please make sure all trash is placed <u>in</u> the dumpster not next to or in front of but <u>in</u> the dumpster. Unfortunately, we have had several reports of people not disposing of trash incorrectly. No large bulk items (furniture, TV's, etc.) should be placed in dumpsters. You are responsible for disposal of larger items Do NOT put oil in the trash dumpsters! It leaks out and causes many environmental issues.

Make sure you pick up all trash from grassy areas—maintenance has trouble mowing with bottles/trash/trash bags all over.

Do NOT drive on the grassy areas.

When using the laundry facilities please remove your clean clothes as soon as possible so that others may use the laundry facilities.



Maintenance calls-

When calling in a work order, please speak clearly/slowly and provide: name, address (property name), and issue. For emergency calls Maintenance will return your call—however, if your phone blocks unknown calls they will not be able to reach you. Please remove this feature when waiting for a return call from Maintenance.

Examples of emergencies are (but not limited to):

Plumbing leaks which could flood the unit or cause damage; electrical hazards; no hear/ac; clogged toilet, tub, sink if on a weekend and you have no second toilet/tub; and a completely clogged kitchen sink.
