What Is a Maintenance

Emergency?



Ever wonder if your maintenance need is an emergency or not? Here is a list of possible maintenance emergencies to help when you call in your work order. Maintenance may be contacted after hours for the following emergencies:

Possible Maintenance Emergencies

Locked out of your unit

•Broken Locks which affect the security of the unit

Broken window glass which affects the security of the unit and during inclement weather

•Plumbing/sprinkler leaks which could flood the unit or cause damage to the unit

Backed up sewage

Electrical hazards

No heat

Smoke detector not functioning

Clogged toilet or tub-if on a weekend

•Completely clogged kitchen sink

Refrigerator/Freezer not working

•Stove or oven not working and tenant plans to use it before the office opens

Fresh Express

Fresh Express is a food program that is offered through Central PA Food Bank in Harrisburg. This is an in person food selection event held at the Valley Terrace Community Center on usually the last Tuesday of the month. Residents bring bags and make food selections from items provided by the Central PA Foodbank. Usually there is a protein, milk, eggs, cheese, fresh produce and dry goods. Mount Vernon residents may come at 12:pm. May Fresh Express is Tuesday the 31st and June Fresh Express is Tuesday the 28th. If you have not enrolled/come to Fresh Express in the past year and would like to begin attending contact Lydia to enroll at extension 110.

Senior boxes (CSFP & Eldershare) with additional shelf-stable items are also available for those who meet eligibility income levels (\$18,210 and below for 1 person, \$24,690 for 2 person household) and are age 60+. You must enroll ahead of time for these programs and commit to picking up your box every month. If interested schedule a time with Lydia to enroll.




Free Meals Brought To You by Restoration Church and Be The Village

Senior Fruit & Veggie Farmers Market Voucher Enrollment



The Franklin County Office Area Agency on Aging will be at the Valley Terrace Community Center Tuesday, June 7th at 1:30 pm to enroll residents in the Senior Farmer Market voucher program and distribute Fruit and Veggie Vouchers. To be eligible you must be 60 years old or older (or will turn 60 by December 31, 2022) and have an income that meets or is below the following guidelines:

\$25,142 for 1 person in the household; or \$33,874 for 2 people in the household.

The Senior Fruit and Veggie Farmers Market vouchers are four \$6 checks accepted by specific produce markets in the area for produce or herbs grown in PA (a list of retailors and produce will be provided).

If you prefer to enroll by mail Lydia can provide you with a paper form.

Covid 2nd Booster Update

The CDC expanded criteria for those who may be at risk for severe outcome from covid to receive a fourth booster. Those over 50 and those who are immune compromised are now eligible for a 4th vaccine shot or second booster if it has been 4 months since their previous booster.

Luminest does not have plans to have Keystone out to administer the booster anytime in the near future but currently booster shots are easily available locally. PA Rent Rebate

The Pennsylvania state rebate program benefits eligible Pennsylvanians age 65 and older; widows and widowers age 50 and older; and people with disabilities age 18 and older. The income limit is \$35,000 a year for homeowners and \$15,000 annually for renters, and half of Social Security income is excluded. Spouses, personal representatives or estates may also file rebate claims on behalf of claimants who lived at least one day in 2021 and meet all other eligibility criteria.

The deadline for the Pennsylvania Rent Rebate program is June 30th! Rent rebates have a component the renter fills out and a certification of paid rent that management fills out. Renters can receive up to \$650 back in form of a rebate. Need an application or help applying?

Affordable Connectivity Program

The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) is a Federal Communications Commission (FCC) Program that provides a discount on monthly broadband bills for qualifying low-income households. Eligible households can receive:

- Up to \$30/month discount for broadband service and associated equipment rentals
- A one-time discount for \$100 for a laptop, desktop, or tablet purchased through a participating provider.

Waynesboro Community and Human

Services

Waynesboro Community & Human Services (WCHS), located at 123 Walnut Street Waynesboro, PA provides a central location for the provision and coordination of a wide variety of human services needed by low income residents of Waynesboro Area and Greencastle Antrim School Districts.

Services available at the Center include Information and referrals, Clothing Bank, Food Bank, Diaper Bank, Emergency Financial Assistance and the Community Nurse Office. Counseling is available from Occupational Vocational Rehabilitation Counseling Services, while we also sponsor a Keystone Health and PA-Career-link satellite offices. Rental Facilities are available at the center for those who have one-time only or ongoing programs that will offer concrete help, emotional support and encouragement and opportunities for personal growth to those who desire such help. When calling in a work order, please speak clearly/slowly and provide: name, address (development name), and issue. Maintenance will usually only return your call if it is an emergency work order call made after hours—however, if your phone blocks unknown calls they will not be able to reach you if they have questions. Please remove this feature after calling in your workorder particularly if it is after hours. Please be aware that usually maintenance does not return calls for work orders that are non-emergency nor for emergency calls during regular hours unless they need more information
